- Do you have family gatherings? On which occasions?

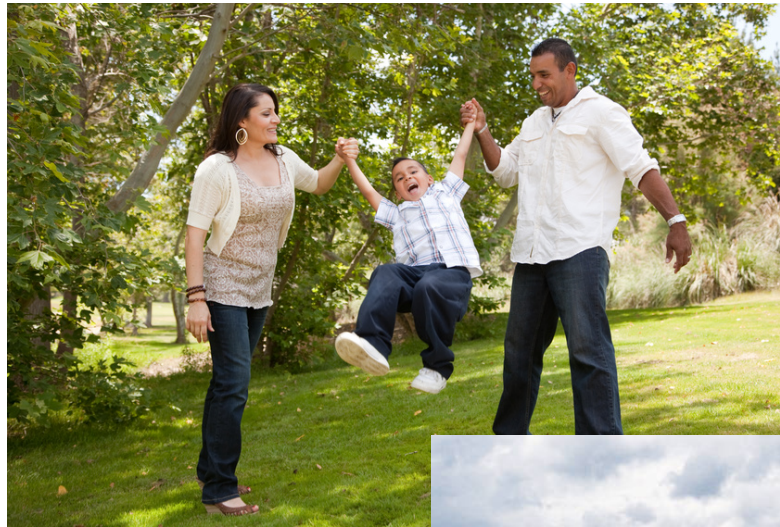
